

SSPF Howard & Dorothy Butler Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Policies

The Howard and Dorothy Butler Memorial Scholarship is awarded through the Scrabble School Preservation Foundation, Inc. The scholarship ranges from \$500-1,000 and is awarded to a student(s) who strive to continue their education in a 2-year, 4-year, or other institution of higher learning leading to a career reflective of the student's knowledge, training, abilities, skills, and passion, in order to impact the community at large. Students are eligible through the age of 24 (before April 1st of the year the application is submitted). The guidelines for awarding the scholarship are as follows:

- ▶ Applicants **must** be a graduate of a high school, public or private (or G.E.D. equivalent) and not over 24 years of age by April 1st of the application year.
- ▶ Two letters of recommendation **must** accompany the application; one must be from someone not related to the applicant.
- ▶ Application **must** include proof of grade point average for High School and the most recent school of higher education where they are currently enrolled.
- ▶ Application **must** include one wallet size photograph of the applicant (may be sent by jpeg format).
- ▶ Application **must** be received by the specified date shown below.
- ▶ All required signatures **must** be completed as requested on the application.
- ▶ Scholarship Board representatives may interview finalists in person or by online meeting.
- ▶ **For RCHS graduating Seniors only!** Rappahannock County High School graduating Seniors, Washington, VA , do NOT need to submit a separate application if they applied for any other Scrabble School Preservation Foundation, Inc. scholarship, e.g., the "**Julia E. Boddie Scholarship**".
- ▶ Once the applicant receives notification of an award, and upon successful proof of attendance, and submission of mid-term grades, a check for the scholarship amount will be sent to the school/university in the applicant's name. Due to taxation laws, checks cannot be sent directly to students. Once information is submitted, allow at least 30 days to verify and transmit monies.
